



ZONE 12 SELECTION POLICY

Objectives

The objective of Zone 12 Bowling Association Selection Committee is to ensure the best possible squads, sides, team and and/or individuals are selected to represent Zone 12 at nominated Bowls NSW and Interzone events.

To enhance opportunities for players / officials for higher representations and/or to assist players / officials current representative level.

Policy Application

The policy applies to all positions of players, coaches and team managers.

All selected personnel will be subject to the Bowls NSW and Zone 12 code of conduct.

In order to be eligible for selection as a player or official for Zone 12 representative matches they must be:

1. A registered bowling member of Bowls NSW or Womens Bowls NSW.
2. Have a declared a club that is affiliated within the Zone 12 / Lansdowne District pennant competition.
3. In the case of selecting females (19-25) in U/25 competitions, they must be affiliated with Womens Bowls NSW.

Player Selection Criteria

Selection may be based on the following criteria:

1. Performance in Club Championships and Zone 12 Pennants
2. Performance in District/ Zone / State Championships
3. Performance in District / Zone/ State Representative fixtures
4. Demonstrated and potential ability to work with other players, officials to improve the standing of Zone 12 within Bowls NSW.
5. Demonstrated positive attitude and commitment to bowls to improve the standing of Zone 12 but also other individual team members.
6. Behaviour standards on and off the bowling green and a total commitment to maintain expected standards of Zone 12, Bowls NSW and Womens Bowls NSW.
7. Availability and commitment to participate in Zone fixtures such as trials and Zone Championships
8. Juniors will not be considered for Zone 12 Open side representation.
9. Juniors may be considered for U/25 representation

Non Playing Selection Criteria

Selections may be based on the following criteria:

1. In determining the composition of any selected side or team the make up of that side or team may be influenced by the importance of long term vision of Zone 12 Bowling Association objectives.
2. At the discretion of selection committee chairman, the selection committee may consult with or seek input with individual players, the leadership group or the team as a whole.

Player and Official removal from squad and/or team

Any person who:

Brings Bowls NSW, Zone 12 Bowling Association team or side, the sport of bowls into disrepute or acts in a manner unbecoming or prejudicial to the interest of Bowls NSW and the sport of bowls.

Breaches or fails to comply, fulfil and observe the requirement of the Bowls NSW and Zone 12 Bowling Association Code of Conduct.

A selection Committee Chairman, Selection Committee member or team manager may be removed by Executive Committee of Zone 12 Bowling Association if they fail to meet the above criteria.

Notification of Selection

Individual players, if possible, shall be notified by phone, email as soon as possible after their individual selection has been finalised within the relevant squad/team or side.

Clubs will be informed of selected sides and asked to contact any players from their clubs that have been selected.
